#### **Townhome Siding and Painting Project Update**

Four phases have been approved and the fourth phase is coming to a close for 2019. One third of the townhomes will be completed by the end of 2019. Please continue to keep your personal items out of the landscaping common areas and continue to keep the backyard items clear of the exterior of the building in preparation for the maintenance project. Failure to assist in the access to the backyards for maintenance has resulted in delays and additional costs. Furthermore, no items should be attached anywhere on the townhome buildings or visible above the rear fence line without prior Architectural Review Committee approval. We greatly appreciate your assistance and cooperation.



Holiday decorations for the townhomes may not be attached to or hung on the buildings. Decorations may show only from the inside of the townhomes. All decorations for both townhomes and patio homes must be removed by January 15th, 2020. As some Halloween and Harvest decorations are still up, please help keep the community clean of pumpkins, etc.

#### Pets

The Association appreciates all of the responsible pet owners who clean up messes left behind during walks. Dogs must be kept on leash whenever they are outside of their own yard and in any of the common areas. We encourage all pet owners to pick up the dog waste, every time. This helps to keep the community clean and helps to keep every resident and pet safe.

When you take your dog out, please take along a plastic bag or take one from one of the Fido stations and tie it to your pet's leash for easy access. Please dispose of waste in the Fido trash cans or large dump-sters after securing your bag.
