SWIMMING POOL RULES & REGULATIONS

The summer months have arrived! Take a review our swimming pool rules and regulations for all residents of Park Scottsdale II. These rules have been made to comply with Insurance Guidelines and County Health Ordinances for your safety. The complete list of pool rules is posted on the Clubhouse arcadia door facing the pool. Parents, make sure you go over these rules with your children and they understand them.

Swimming instructors are not allowed to use our pool for lessons. This practice would increase our insurance rates.

Do not let anyone in the swimming pool area unless they are a resident with a pool key. Lost your pool key! Dorothy Michel will issue a replacement for \$35. All guests (limit of 4 per unit) must be accompanied to the pool by a resident. Children age 10-and-under must be accompanied by a responsible adult, 18 years or older.

1. THE POOL GATE MUST BE CLOSED/LOCKED AT ALL TIMES.
2. Bathing suits must be worn in the pool. (No cut-offs)
3. No "Nude sun-bathing or women going topless. (Decency Ordinance - City of Scottsdale)
4. Radios are allowed ONLY with the use of headphones.
5. The pool Safety Equipment is for EMERGENCY USE only. Children must not play with this equipment.
6. No food, glass containers or intoxicating beverages in the pool area.
7. No running or rough-house play.
8. No inner tubes or rafts in the pool. Life tings on small children are allowed.
9. No bikes or skateboards.
10. No playing with balls or frisbees. It is dangerous and absolutely forbidden to throw anything in the pool area.
11. No urinating in the pool or in the common property. Dirtied diapers must NOT be placed in the trash containers. Should the City or County Health Inspectors find this occurrence our pool would be closed.
12. No PETS.

People who use the pool do so at their OWN RISK. Residents are responsible for the safety and behavior of their children and their guests. Failure to comply with the rules will result in:

- 1st Offense: A warning and suspension of pool privileges for a day.
2nd Offense: A suspension of pool privileges for 3 days and notification of responsible party.
3rd Offense: Pool suspension until the Board meets to decide what course of action to take.
