Compliance Corner

It is that time of year! Those pesky weeds just seem to pop-up and grow right before our eyes. While it may appear like nothing is being done about the blighted home on your street, your association is citing homes in violation and will ultimately clean the yard at the owners expense.

If the wood on your fascia s in bad shape, discolored, or in disrepair, please repair or touch up the paint as necessary. In addition, please inspect the condition of your window screens. Replace faded or damaged screens. **The association will be sending violation notices for those homes that remain in non-compliance.**

Is it time to paint?

As you drive by or walk around your neighborhood, you can't help but notice how time and weather has taken a toll on the paint of some of our homes. If the home has not been painted since it was built, it may also be time to repaint. In March of 2016 the association will begin sending notices to homes in need of painting. Please remember, a Design Review Application will need to be submitted and approved by the community's Architectural Review Committee **before** any painting is started.

Exterior Home Painting

It's important that each owner start conducting a visual inspection of the exterior paint on their home. Some of homes are in need of repainting due to the harsh sun exposure and age of the paint. Signs to look for are:

- Chalky appearance may be a sign that the exterior paint is breaking down.
- Fading/Chipping of paint
- Exposed Wood
- Make sure that you are inspecting areas that may have water damage due to irrigation and sprinkler systems.

Architectural Applications

Applications must be entirely completed with any supplemental drawings, blueprints, measurements and/or paint samples to be considered and approved. Homeowners are required to obtain approval prior to any work being completed on the exterior.
