HOUSE INFO: No slowdown in home values... The median sale price in the greater Phoenix area is now \$360K. Since January, the sales price per square foot for a home between \$300K-\$400K has appreciated 6%. That's approximately 2% per month and the current sale price to list price ratio within the price range is 102.4%. If this rate of appreciation continues in the short term, a buyer who paid 4% over asking price on a \$360K home (\$14,400 over) would recoup their investment through appreciation in approximately 2 months.
