ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

(a non-profit corporation)

In compliance with the requirements of Section 10-3201, et seq., Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, the undersigned incorporator, who is of full age, has this day voluntarily associated himself for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation, and does hereby certify:

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

The name of the Corporation is Superstition Commons Owners Association, an Arizona nonprofit corporation (the "Association").

ARTICLE II

The principal place of business of the Association shall be 8220 E Palm Lane, Mesa Az 85207, but it may establish other offices in such other places, either within or without the State of Arizona, as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine.

ARTICLE III

The Association does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profits to the members thereof and the specific purposes for which it is formed are to provide for the construction, management, maintenance, preservation and care of the common elements (as defined in the Declaration Establishing Superstition Commons Owners Association, Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, to be recorded in the records of Maricopa county, Arizona, hereinafter referred to as "Declaration") on the real property located in the County of Maricopa, State of Arizona and to perform such other duties as are imposed upon the Association under the Declaration, these Articles, and the Bylaws adopted by the Association, all of which hereafter shall be referred to as the "Condominium Documents," and to conduct all lawful affairs for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Arizona, as they may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE IV

The character of the business which the Association shall initially engage in is to provide for the management, maintenance and care of the Common Elements (as defined in the Declaration) and to exercise and perform such other powers and duties as are imposed upon or granted to the Association under the Arizona Condominium Act and the Condominium Documents.

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ARTICLE V

Membership in the Association shall be limited to the Unit Owners (as defined in the Declaration). Each Unit Owner shall have such rights, privileges and votes in the Association as are set forth in the Condominium Documents. The Superstitute Commons Duners Association will have members.

The corporation will have members.

ARTICLE VI

The control and management of the affairs of the Association shall be vested in a Board of Directors of not less than three (3) nor more than eight (8) persons. The name and addresses of the initial directors of the Association who shall serve as Directors until the first annual meeting of the members or until their successors are elected and qualified, are as follows:

Bylaws of the Association shall prescribe the terms of office and manner of election of directors.

ARTICLE VII

The private property of each and every officer, director and member of the Association shall at all times be exempt from all debts and liabilities of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X

The personal liability of any director of the Association to the Association or its members for monetary damages for breach of his/her fiduciary duties as a director is hereby eliminated but, except to the permitted by the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act, the provisions of this Article shall not eliminate or limit the liability of a director for any of the acts set forth in Section 10-3202 (B), Arizona Revised Statues.

ARTICLE XI

Each fiscal year for the Association shall begin on January 1st and end on December 31st.

ARTICLE XII

These Articles may be amended by Members representing at least sixty-six (66%) of the total votes in the Association.
