## **HOUSE INFO:**

Patio Conversions... We see some of our neighbors enclosing their patios. We reached out to an appraiser to see if it truly adds square footage to the home. Her response below:

It needs to be built with a permit first and foremost. Other factors include a heating and cooling source (spilt until ok or ducted with good air flow) but not window wall unit. Insulation and same grade level as the main dwelling (not a step down) are other factors that may influence whether or not it gets counted as gross livable area.

## LANDSCAPE TIP OF THE MONTH:

September is a great time to transplant materials (plants and trees) so that they can be established before our first frost.

•If you're interested in herbs, it's nice to keep them close to the kitchen door for quick picking. Do small transplants in September such as mint thyme and basil.

•If you did not fertilize in August, now is the perfect time for your last fertilizing for lemons and limes.
