COMMUNITY INFO: The South Central Extension/Downtown Hub will connect with the current light rail system in downtown Phoenix and operate south to Baseline Road. The project also includes a hub in downtown Phoenix, new stations and public art. Today, more than 45,000 riders rely on light rail each day. Light rail has proven to generate economic prosperity for historically underserved communities in metro Phoenix. Light rail makes the unique offerings of South Phoenix more accessible to others, attracting new customers, businesses and jobs to the area. In 2016, the Phoenix City Council approved advancing the opening date of the extension from 2034 to 2023. The advancement is funded through Transportation 2050, a 35-year, multi-modal transportation plan approved by Phoenix voters, and is expected to open for operations in 2024.

LANDSCAPE TIP OF THE MONTH: Avoid any substantial pruning till spring. Our possible low temps could be damaging. If we fall to 32 degrees and below, cover with front cloth, lightweight sheets, etc. but do not use plastic. It is a great time for planting annuals and a perfect time to plant shrubs and trees to establish root growth for spring.
