LEARN ABOUT WHAT IT MEANS TO LIVE IN AN HOA: Overnight Street parking is not allowed in our community per the CC&R's and we have a special enforcement document to address this. If the HOA tags your car 3 times — regardless of how much time has passed — it can and will be towed without warning. If you need to park on the street, you can reach out to Vision Community Mgt for a 48-hour exception pass.
