#### PETS

The Association appreciates all of the responsible pet owners who clean up their pet's waste. We encourage all pet owners to pick up their pet's waste, every time. This helps to keep the community clean, and helps to keep every pet safe. Please remember that dogs must be kept on leashes whenever not enclosed within your property. This helps to ensure the safety of all residents pets in the community. We would also like to remind pet owners to please make sure that your dogs are not constantly barking.

## TRASH AND RECYCLE

Trash containers can be placed out no earlier than 3pm the day prior to collection day and brought in no later than 6am the following day.

## **PARKING REMINDERS**

We'd like to remind all residents that vehicles should be in proper working order if visible from neighboring properties. Inoperable vehicles, including those that are severely wrecked, shows significant or unsafe body damage, in a state of disrepair, lacks license plates or exhibits expired plates are not permitted.

# **ASSESSMENT PAYMENT OPTIONS**

**Automatic Withdrawal:** Payments can be deducted from your checking or savings account automatically via ACH. There is no fee to sign up and it is a great way to avoid late fees without the hassle of having to remember to submit your payment on time. **Online Payment:** One-time eCheck and credit card payments can be made online. Keep your statement handy as information contained in your statement is required to complete an online transaction.
