There is no charge to residents of Silverhawke HOA to use common areas. As a measure to regulate the use of SVH common areas/park by organized youth sports teams, an approved Request Form is required. Because of homeowner concerns related to, but not limited to, parking, HOA liability, park over-crowding and use by teams who have no SVH representation; The SVH HOA Board of Directors requires organized teams to submit this form with sufficient information regarding eligibility (verified with picture ID showing residence in the SVH HOA, renters will need an endorsement from property owner), planned use (what sport, number of participants, times of use) and "Additional Insurance". Park/Common area use is determined on a first come, first served basis. There is only one team allowed to practice in any common area (green belt) at a time.

If you will have any type of Extras or Toys in the Park, please identify the product, the company, and supply this office with a Certificate of Insurance from the company with the Silverhawke HOA Park/Common Area as an additional insured entity for this occasion. All Information must be submitted to this office **prior** to the occasion.

Upon approval of this request, I agree that: The approved form and picture ID must be present at all times during reserved use; The area to be used will be cleaned up after our use of the HOA facilities; All trash will be removed from the area(s); Any issues or problems will be reported to Jen Amundson, Community Manager, Vision Management Company, 480-759-4945.
